If the book you're citing is a second or later edition (i.e. when the edition is stated on the title page or cover), specify this in your reference. Abbreviate 'edition' to 'edn' or 'revised edition' to 'rev ed'. When referencing a book published in multiple volumes, include the total number of volumes in your reference.

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Citing Textbooks in the APA Style Compile a list of all the relevant details of the textbook you are referencing, including such details as the name (s) of the author (s) and editor (s), the year and city of publication and the publisher's name. Include the page numbers and the edition number of each reference.

To cite an online journal or newspaper article, the page numbers section from the print journal or newspaper reference is swapped with the URL or DOI the article can be accessed from and when it was accessed. So the reference for an online journal article is: Author surname (s), initial (s).

How to Cite Sources in Harvard Citation Format - Mendeley

APA style is a common requirement for papers written in the social sciences. When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

When citing an introduction, a preface, a foreword, or an afterword, write the name of the author (s) of the piece you are citing. Then give the name of the part being cited, which should not be italicized or enclosed in quotation marks; in italics, provide the name of the work and the name of the author of the introduction/preface/foreword/afterword.

One way to cite a quotation, paraphrase, or other borrowed information in text is to introduce the author in the sentence. If the textbook was written by more than one author, list all the names. Only use the last name, unless there are two authors with the same last name. In that instance, include the first initial, as well.

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

Revised on June 19, 2020. An MLA book citation always includes the author (s), title (italicized), publisher, and publication year in the list of Works Cited. If relevant, include the names of any editors or translators, the edition, and the volume. The in-text citation gives the author's last name and a page number in parentheses.

Cite your book. In the above citation example, the book, The Body of the Queen: Gender and Rule in the Courtly World, 1500-2000 is an edited book that features a chapter by Louis Montrose. The title of the chapter that he wrote is found in quotation marks ("Elizabeth Through the Looking Glass: Picturing the Queen's Two Bodies").

In-text citations: Author-page style MLA format follows the author-page method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the page number (s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

Citing an open textbook is like citing any online textbook. Therefore, as the author and publisher of an open textbook, it is your job to provide the elements required for a complete reference, regardless of citation style, such as: textbook title, author(s) or editor(s), copyright year, and publisher name and place.
